When using Coze, you pay for Coze capabilities with usage-based charges.

Coze offers you an on-demand approach. You only pay for the capabilities you use. There are no additional costs.

## Charges overview

Coze charges you by deducting certain Coze tokens or credits from your account. To ensure uninterrupted access to these capabilities, you need to purchase Coze tokens or credits.

- When chargeable functions are used via API or web SDK, the incurred costs are deducted from your account. For example, Coze tokens are deducted from your account to cover the model fees.
- When chargeable functions are used in scenarios *other than* using API or web SDK, the incurred costs are deducted from your account using credits. For example, credits are deducted from your account to cover the costs of using the Coze platform.

The following table lists the capabilities that are in charge at present.

Charges	Description
Model Charge	Coze provides a diverse set of models with different capabilities, language understanding, and complex question answering.  Depending on the way that you are using the model, either Coze tokens or credits are deducted from your account.
Plugin Charge	Coze provides various official plugins to facilitate AI application development. You will be charged only when certain plugins are used. Depending on the way that you are using the plugin, either Coze tokens or credits are deducted from your account.

## Coze token deduction (API/Web SDK)

The Coze token is a settlement resource that you can purchase from Coze. Coze tokens are used to deduct the **plugin charges** incurred when using the Coze API and Web SDK.

The following table lists the APIs that may consume Coze tokens.

Note

Each Coze account is granted 30 free API calls and 100 Web SDK calls. If there are more API calls than the free quota, the extra API calls will be affected. For more information on purchasing Coze tokens, see [Purchase Coze tokens](#).

<a href="#">Chat</a>	Model Charge	When sending a chat request to an agent or app with a model configured in the agent or app will result in charges. These model fees are deducted using Coze tokens, which includes consumed input and output tokens.
	Plugin Charge	If an agent or app is configured with any of the following plugins, plugin fees will incur when sending a chat request to an agent or app using the Chat API. These plugin fees are deducted using Coze tokens. For the price of chargeable official plugins, see <a href="#">here</a> .
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><a href="#">Run workflow</a></li><li><a href="#">Run workflow (streaming response)</a></li></ul>	Model Charge	If a workflow is configured with one or more LLM nodes, charges will be incurred when using these two APIs to run the workflow. These model fees are deducted using Coze tokens, which includes consumed input and output tokens.
	Plugin Charge	If a workflow is configured with any of the following plugins, plugin fees will incur when using these two APIs to run the workflow. These plugin fees are deducted using Coze tokens. For the price of chargeable official plugins, see <a href="#">here</a> .

Credits deduction (Usage other than API/Web SDK)

Credit is another settlement resource that you can purchase from Coze. Credits are incurred in scenarios other than the Coze API and Web SDK.

The calculation for the deducted message credits is as follows:

**Deducted credits = Number of model calls × model price + Number of plu**

• Model and plugin calls

A single conversation or workflow may involve multiple model calls or official plugin configuration, such as in scenarios with function calls, or workflows configured with multiple nodes.

You can view the number of model and plugin calls for each conversation in the following table. Actions may trigger calls to models or plugins:

- agent or app test
- A workflow test
- An executed scheduled trigger
- An executed shortcut command

• Model price

The number of credits varies by models as listed in the following table.

Test or chat with an agent or app

When testing an agent or app on the Coze platform from the **Preview** panel, or from the Coze Store, Discord, Telegram and other channels, credits will be deducted from your account for the model calls and the model the agent or app uses.

Test a workflow with LLM node

If a workflow is configured with model or plugin nodes, credits will be deducted from your account for the workflow in the workflow editor.

The deduction is based on the number of test runs and the model or plugin the workflow uses.

Note

The Coze platform offers each account 10 free workflow trial runs per day, during which no credits are charged. After the free quota is exhausted, credits will be deducted based on the model or plugin used.

Scheduled trigger with prompt

If a scheduled trigger is configured with a model or plugin, credits will be deducted from your account when the event is triggered.

The deduction is based on the number of triggered events and the model the agent or app uses.

- If this scheduled task is triggered in multiple channels, each channel will be charged from the agent or app developer's account.

Note

No credits will be deducted if this scheduled task is triggered in Coze Store

- If this scheduled task is triggered by end users, the credits will be deducted from your account if the **message billing settings option** is enabled.

Shortcut commands

If a shortcut is configured for an agent or app and the shortcut uses a model or plugin, you will be charged every time the agent or app users use the shortcut command.
