How usage-based billing works

- 1 **Allowance first.** Each seat includes a monthly usage allowance — most customers stay well within it.
- 2 **Then the shared pool.** Add-ons (Accounting, Website) contribute to a shared pool, used after seat allowances.
- 3 **Overage only up to your cap.** Go past your allowance and usage is billed in small per-action increments — but never above your monthly cap.
- 4 **Beyond the cap is free.** Once you reach the cap, any additional usage that month costs nothing. No surprise bills, ever.

What counts as usage?

- Metered actions like **AI features** and **receipt scanning**
- Billed in small increments, drawn from your allowance first
- Everyday work — CRM, estimates, invoices, projects — is included

Good to know

- Seat & add-on changes **prorate** mid-month
- Prices in **CAD**, before applicable tax
- **Monthly billing** — no annual commitment required
